Great Backyard Bird Count

On February 14-17, the National Audubon Society, along with the Cornell Lab of Ornithology, is hosting its 6th Annual Great Backyard Bird Count. Help us make this a great nationwide event!

You don't need to do anything to register in advance. Just select a site (most choose their own backyard) and count the number of birds you see. Note each species and the largest number you see at any one time. At the end of the day, report your results via the internet at the GBBC website. For more information, go to the GBBC website at <http://www.birdsource.org/gbbc/> for detailed information on participation.

Audubon will provide sites to report results if you don't have access to the internet. Call the phone numbers below for details. The Audubon Chapter of Minneapolis has planned a couple of ways you can participate. On Saturday, February 15, we have three choices for you:

- ◆ From 10:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. at Springbrook Nature Center in Fridley
- ◆ From 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. at Westwood Hills Nature Center in St. Louis Park
- ◆ From 10:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. at Wood Lake Nature Center in Richfield

There will be Audubon members to help with bird identification and some binoculars will be available to borrow. Come with friends, watch, and have fun with others. It is anticipated that some Audubon members will be hosting parties where birding enthusiasts can gather to observe birds or to gather before departing to their favorite birding site to do their counts. Pass this information to everyone you know. Host your own party for your friends! There will be prizes for participants, especially those who decide to join Audubon during the Count. On February 4, Steve Weston of the Minnesota River Valley Audubon Chapter will present a lively and informative program on the 12 species of owls found in Minnesota. He promises to teach us a successful call that is not found on any of the tapes!

Originally from New York City, Steve migrated to the Midwest and settled in Minnesota after graduate school. Here his passion for birding began in his backyard on Quigley Lake. For the last 12 years, he has introduced many people to the pleasures and excitement of birding as a field trip leader for Audubon, Dakota County Parks, and the Boy Scouts. He is active in Audubon and the Minnesota Ornithologists Union and frequently drives across the state to follow up on rare bird sightings. His family has felt the need to resort to limiting his access to binoculars, especially while driving!

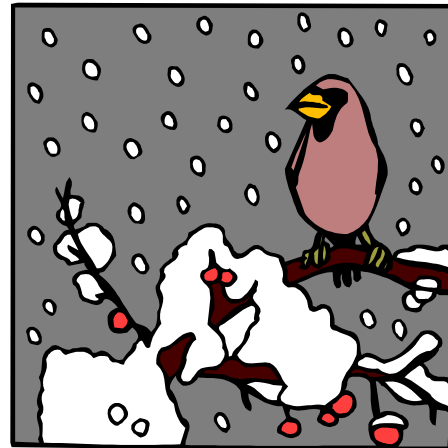
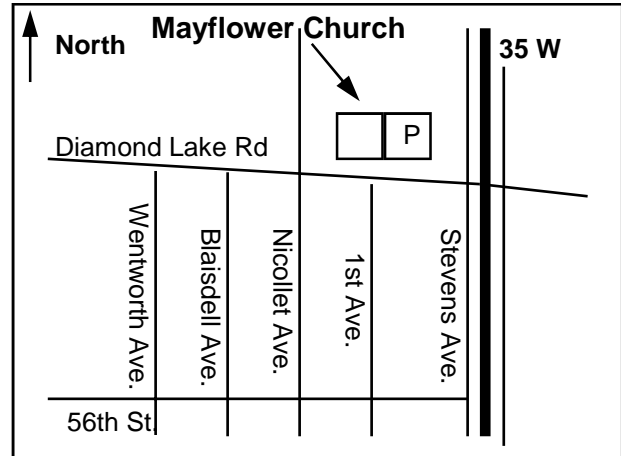
